## Requirements for the submission of abstracts and papers:

The papers have to relate to the theme of the congress and shall not exceed 20 pages. They shall be sent in electronic format for their publication in the program and CD-ROM of the event. These publications shall be registered in the Book Chamber under the label of the Publishing House EDICIONES ICAIC (with its ISBN code). The paper might also be selected as original article or reprint to be published in MEDICC Review magazine.

The papers in order to be published shall be organized in the following way:

Abstract: Abstracts shall be submitted in a structured or non structured form. The formers shall not exceed 150 word and the latters may reach 250 words. Abstracts must contain the aims of the study, methods, results and conclusion. It must have 3 to 10 key words. We require the abstract of your proposed presentation as soon as possible and no later than April 30, 2009 and shall be sent to margarita@clamed.sld.cu

#### Paper:

It shall be sent to the above email before June 25, 2009 and shall contain an abstract, introduction, objectives, results, discussion, conclusions and recommendations. Each item shall be typed in uppercase letters in bold print.

### **Style and format:**

<u>Paper title</u>: should be typed in 14-point Arial, justified alignment and bold print. <u>The name of authors</u>: name of authors, academic titles, teaching and scientific category, work center, telephone number, email address, city, country shall be typed in bold. The name of the speaker shall be underlined.

The document: font arial 12 points, justified. Text margin 2.5 cm in sheets (8 1/2 x 11).

The scientific commission shall inform the acceptance of the papers and the form of presentation at the congress after July 31, 2009.
