Abstracts must include: title, full name of primary author(s), name of presenter, institution, institutional address, country, contact telephone/fax, e-mail, and preferred form of presentation. In case of lectures, workshops or round table discussions, please specify all necessary audiovisual aids.

Each abstract should be no longer than 250 words and should include introduction, objectives, methods, results, conclusions.

# **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

The registration fee, as well as all the payments in Cuba, will be in Cuban Convertible Pesos (CUC), the official currency within the country.

Money can be exchanged upon your arrival in Cuba (at the airport, hotels, the Conference Center, banks, and at CADECA – Currency Exchange Offices located throughout the city) at the current exchange rate of the day. (At the present time the exchange rate for the Cuban Convertible Peso (CUC) is equivalent to the going rate of any foreign currency against the US Dollar (\$US) <u>PLUS</u> an additional 8% -- 1.08). The US Dollar itself carries an additional surcharge of 10% (\$US) and thus is exchanging at approximately 18-20% or 1.18–1.20 (vs. 8% - 1.08 - for other foreign currencies). Thus, one USD is equivalent to .80 CUC – or 80 cents CUC to the dollar). This is for currency exchange dealings in cash in Cuba. Contact your travel service provider for further information.

Registration fees can also be paid using the following credit cards: VISA, Master Card, CABAL, VISA Electron - EXCEPT FOR THOSE THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED BY US BANKS. No credit cards issued in the U.S. and/or by U.S. banks can be used in Cuba due to U.S. laws.
