HEALTH CARE SITUATION IN CUBA. BASIC INDICATORS.2008

The aim of this leaflet is to satisfy needs for information by upgrading the knowledge of the country's health status and encouraging the use of statistical information as a powerful tool for the management, research, teaching and communication among the different participants in the health care sector at both national and international levels.

The basic indicators of health care situation in Cuba, which were selected for this material, covering the year 2008 except for those referring to previous years, which have been adequately mentioned in each case.

Basic indicators were grouped in six sections, which represent broad areas classified by their essential contents, are set forth.

The mortality and morbidity statistics have been processed according to the ICD-10

The analysis of this information will allow people to approach to the present Cuban realities, to understand, explain and identify problems and to assess health care actions.







FURTHER NOTES

COMMENTS ON SOME INDICATORS

General fertility rate: Number of live births per every 1 000 women aged 15-49 years.

Global fertility rate: Average number of live births per each woman in her fertile period (15-49 years) according to the specific fertility rates per each age group.

Mortality rate in children under 5 years of age (MRCU5): Ratio of the number of deaths in children under 5 years of age during a given year and the number of live births in that year. The figure is multiplied by 1 000. It is an approximate probability of dying before being 5 years of age.

Maternal death ratio: Ratio of the number of maternal deaths (direct and indirect) and the number of live births in a given year.

Annual mean growth rate of population: Rate of growth of a population. It represents the average number of persons that are annually added to the population per every 1 000 population.

Prevalence of a disease: Total number of sick subjects suffering from some affection in a given period. It is expressed by dividing the mentioned figure by the total population in that period.

Years of potential life lost: It allows to compare the relative importance of different death causes for a population and gives how many years a person fails to live because of certain death causes.

Rate ratio per sex: It is obtained by dividing male rate by female rate or vice versa. In case of mortality rate, it expresses the overmortality of one sex against the other, which is higher as it exceeds 1.

Index of low birth rate: Percent of live births with a weight under 2 500 grams

Adjusted rates: Rates are adjusted by a direct method and the model population was that of the 1981 census in Cuba.

DATA SOURCES

The indicators shown in this leaflet have been prepared by the National Health Statistic Direction of the Cuban Public Health Ministry. The largest volume of statistical information comes from the Statistical Information System of the Health sector, which has statistical departments in health care facilities, and in municipal, provincial and national health care departments. Professionals and highly skill technicians specialized in health statistic technicians specialized in health statistics as well as other experts in information sciences participate in statistical information service.
